How to leave a gift in your Will

Three simple ways to make a difference.

Residuary legacy

This is a share – or possibly even all – of the balance of your estate, once all other payments have been made (eg. lifetime debts, tax, administrative expenses and any pecuniary and specific legacies).

Pecuniary legacy

You may prefer to leave us a fixed amount of money. If you are considering a cash gift, please do consider inflation proofing the legacy.

Specific legacy

This would be a gift of a specific item – such as personal possessions, land, buildings or shares.

Make sure your wishes are known

We know it can be easy to put off, but writing your Will is essential to ensure your loved ones and the causes you care about are taken care of exactly how you wish.

If you already have a Will there is no need to create one from scratch – you can make a simple change by adding a codicil.
