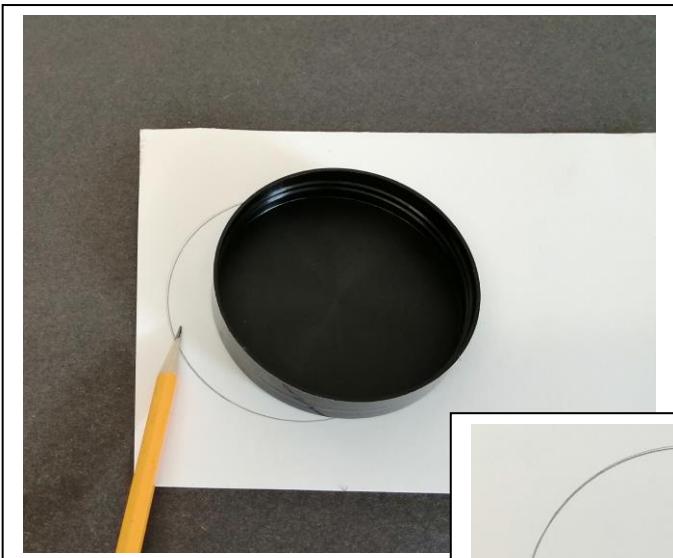


Faces Tutorial
Making an oval template
for the face



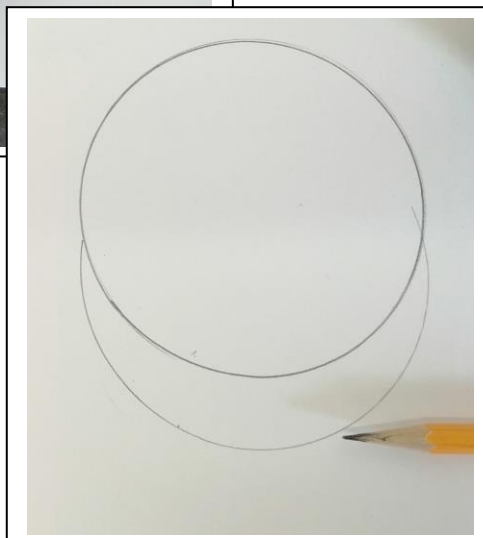
Stage 1

Draw around a lid onto thin card or the back of a cereal packet.



Stage 2

Move the lid down approx 2 – 2.5cm



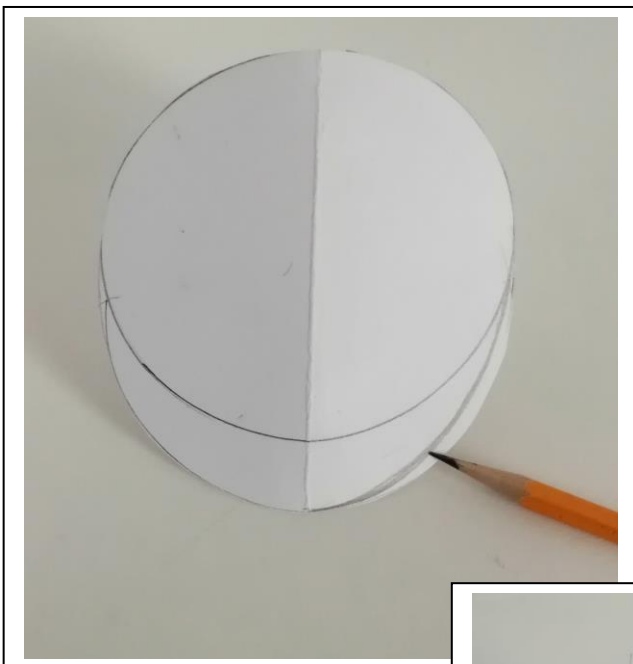
Draw a new line that will form the chin



Stage 3

Cut out the shape smoothing off the line where the two circles meet.

The pencil in the picture indicates this point.

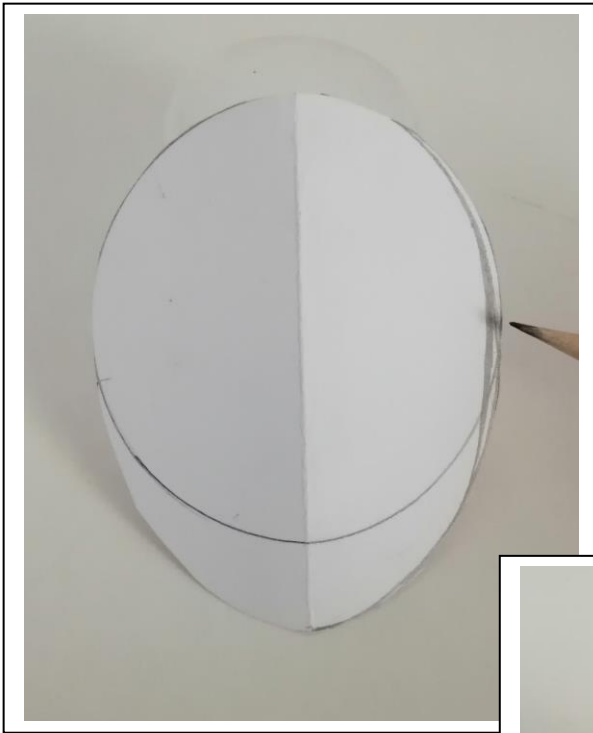


Stage 3

Slim down the chin area as shown.



Fold in half and cut away on the new chin line.

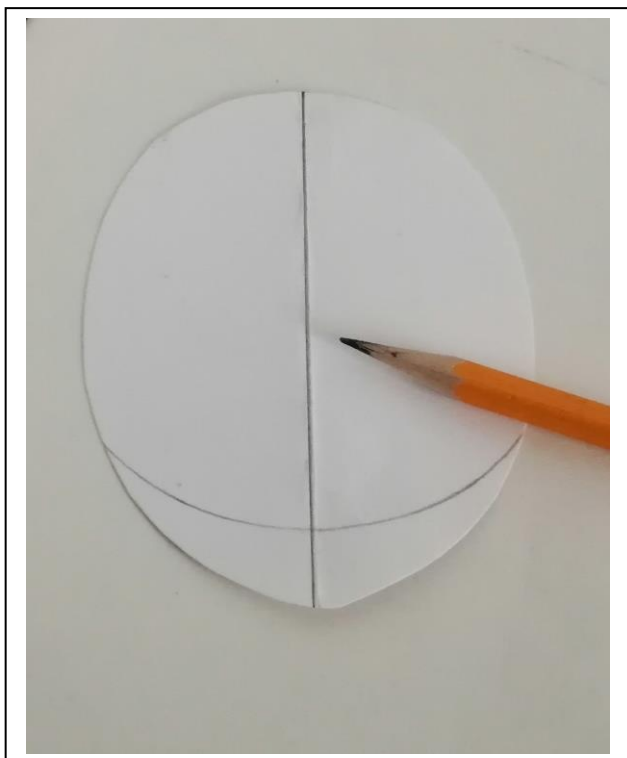


Stage 4

Slim down the side of the head.

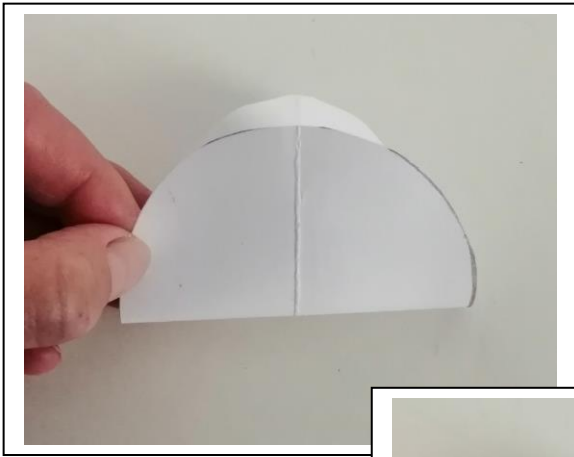


Fold in half and cut away on the new line.



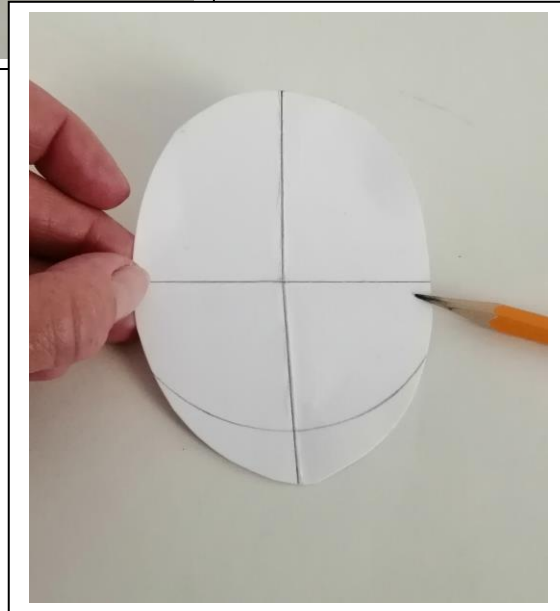
Stage 5

Draw a line down the centre of the face.

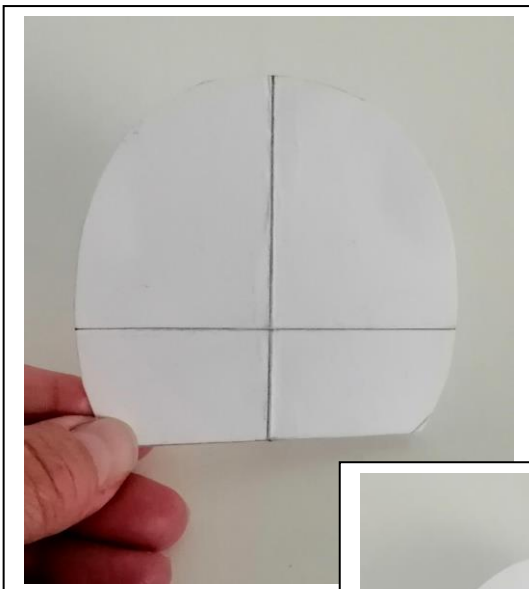


Stage 6

Fold in half - chin to top of the head.



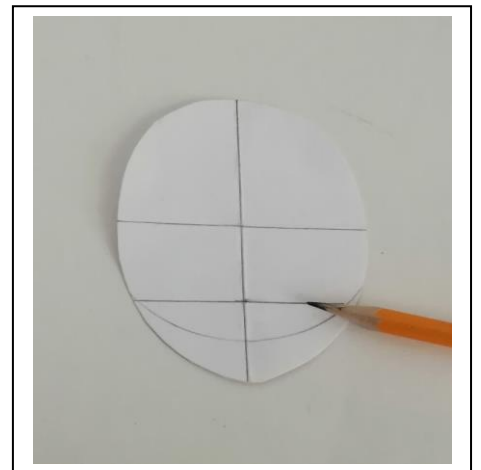
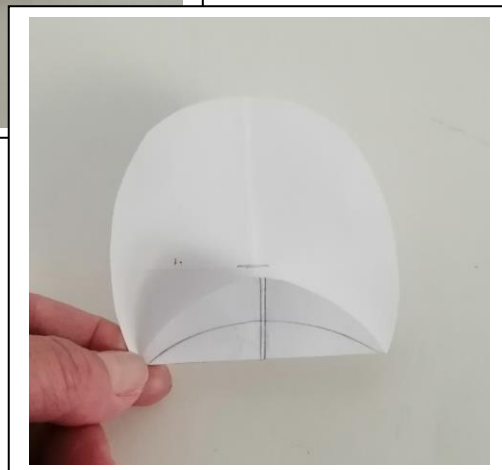
Draw a line along the fold to indicate the eye line.

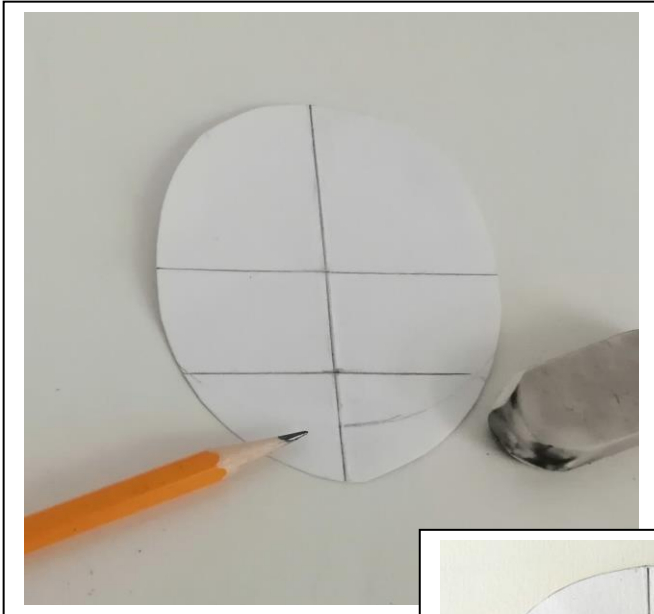


Stage 7

Fold the chin up to the eye line.

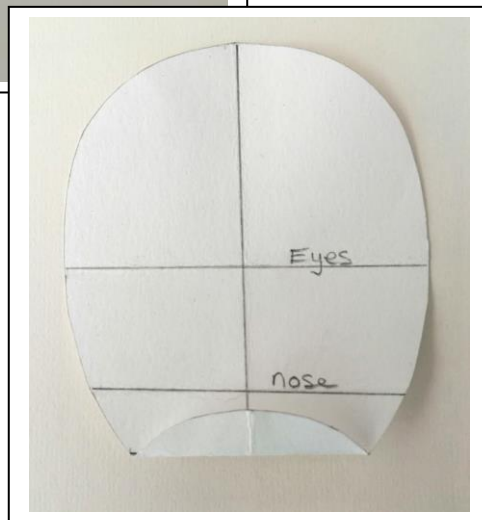
This indicates the position of the nose. Draw a line across.



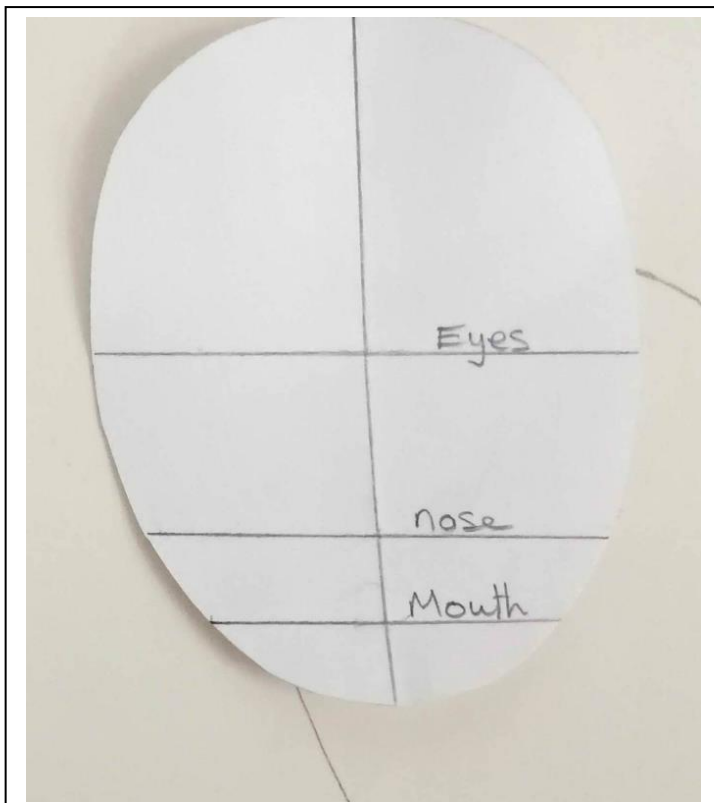


Stage 8

Rub away the curved line and any other marks you don't need.



Fold the chin up to the nose line. This indicates the position of the mouth



You now have a card template that you can use multiple times.

You can alter the shape and character of the head once you start drawing.
